- New Social Studies curriculum
  - Identify and research Indigenous landmarks
  - Selection of 5 landmarks: Head smashed in Buffalo Jump, The Confluence, Okotoks Big rock, Dinosaur provincial park, Writing on Stone

- Loose parts
